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Keynote Speakers



Prof. Frank Giraldo is a professor at the Foreign Languages Department of Universidad de Caldas in Colombia, where he teaches undergraduate and graduate courses in language teaching and assessment. Prof. Giraldo holds a BA in English language Teaching, from Universidad Tecnológica de Pereira in Colombia; an MA in English Didactics from Universidad de Caldas in Colombia; and an MA in Teaching English as a Second Language from University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, in the USA. His main research interest is the interface between Language Assessment Literacy (LAL) and Teachers' Professional Development. He has published articles on language testing and assessment (specifically LAL) and has experience training pre- and in-service teachers in this area of applied linguistics. He is currently the main investigator in the research group called "Semillero de Investigación en Evaluacion de Lenguas Extranjeras" (SIELE). With this group, he is currently researching and fostering the LAL of English teachers from state schools in Colombia.



Prof. Shahid Abrar-ul-Hassan has been working as a language educator, researcher, and teacher developer for over two decades that straddled institutions in many regions of the world. He is currently Professor of English language education at Yorkville University, British Columbia Campus in New Westminster, BC, Canada. He also serves as a TESOL subject expert with the British Columbia Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Training. He is co-editor of the special issue on language assessment literacy of *System* (Elsevier). He has been Visiting Researcher/Professor in universities in the USA and PR China. He has presented professional development workshops at institutions in many countries. His professional areas of interest include learner-centered instruction, ESP/EAP, learner motivation, differentiated teacher development, and, in particular, language assessment.



Prof. Peter Davidson teaches Business Communication and Technical Writing at Zayed University in Dubai, having previously taught in New Zealand, Japan, the UK and Turkey. He has co-edited a number of books, mainly on assessment and technology, including: Language Assessment in the Middle East and North Africa: Theory, Practice and Future Trends (2017, TESOL Arabia); The Cambridge Guide to Second Language Assessment. Cambridge (2012, Cambridge University Press); Computers in English Language Teaching (2010, TESOL Arabia); The Fundamentals of Language Assessment: A Practical Guide for Teachers (2009, TESOL Arabia): and Evaluating Teaching Effectiveness in ESL/EFL Contexts (2007, University of Michigan Press). He has over 120 publications, and has delivered over 140 conference papers at international and local conferences, and has given 85 workshops in 16 different countries. He was recently made a Fellow of the HEA.



Dr. Christine Coombe has a Ph.D. in Foreign/Second Language Education from The Ohio State University and is currently an Associate Professor of General Studies at Dubai Men's College, HCT, in the UAE. Christine has published over 50 books in various topics in TESOL/ELT. Christine has lived and worked in the Gulf for the past 29 years. During her tenure, she has won many awards including: 2002 Spaan Fellowship for Research in Second/Foreign Language Assessment; 2002-03 TOEFL Outstanding Young Scholar Award; the Chancellor's Teacher of the Year for 2003-04; the British Council's International Assessment Award for 2013 and was named to TESOL's 50@50 which "recognizes professionals who have made significant contributions to the TESOL profession within the past 50 years." Dr Coombe is the 2018 recipient of the James E. Alatis Award which recognizes exemplary service to TESOL. Her most recent honor was being named to the US Department of State's 30@30 English language specialists in 2021. This list recognizes ElSpecs who have made an impact on the teaching and training of English language teachers around the world in the last 30 years. Dr. Coombe served as TESOL International Association President (2011-2012) and was a member of the TESOL Board of Directors (2010-2013).



Prof. Bava Harji Madhubala is an experienced Associate Professor with a demonstrated history of working in the higher education industry. She is skilled in Lecturing, Educational Technology, Instructional Design, and Curriculum Development. She is a strong education professional with a Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) focused in TESL from Multimedia University.
